

I've put together a very quick map showing the state assets that we are aware of, all vacant and derelict units, and a very quick search for possible vacant sites.

The map needs a lot of tidying up but let me know if its useful and if you want anything else added to it. The layers in the map include:

I will touch back with you tomorrow evening to discuss how we're going. Thanks.




