

Hi

I understand you were speaking with Eamonn this morning, and I thought it might be worthwhile providing some details of the surveys required at this time.

As part of our planning strategy, the LDA has to complete some further intrusive site surveys before a valid planning application can be submitted to Cork City Council.

Due to the nature of the existing line of mature trees which contain sensitive ecological receptors and protected species (i.e. bats), it is important to the LDA to not fell any mature trees within the site without consent as we are keen to limit the loss of any specimen trees in general as well as disruption to habitats without valid mitigation measures agreed with Cork City Council.

There are a number of site surveys that the LDA must complete prior to the submission of a planning application. Some have already been completed and some of the outstanding ones include:

- 1. Trial Pitting (machinery below)
- 2. Plate Testing (machinery below)
- 3. Cable Percussion Boreholing (machinery below)
- 4. Topographical/Utilities Surveying (small and light machinery)
- 5. Breeding Birds Surveying (ecologist walking site)

Some of the above do not include heavy machinery and can be carried out by accessing the site via the greenfield entrance. Others (1-3) will need access via the main ESB entrance to circumnavigate the mature tree line that restricts access via the greenfield entrance.

Surveys 1-4 (above) would appear as follows on site:



Trial Pitting – excavator required and allows subsurface soil types and relative thicknesses to be accurately recorded.






Plate Testing - to determine the allowable and ultimate bearing capacity of the ground.



Cable Percussion Boreholing - used for Geotechnical and Environmental ground investigations.

For all of our surveys we prepare and submit Risk Assessment Management Strategies (attached) to ESB Networks for approval prior to accessing the site, who have been very accommodating to date which has been much appreciated.

Survey durations are always intended to be carried out as quickly as possible, but this can be dependent on weather and other externals. The anticipated durations for surveys 1-3, which we require to undertake as soon as possible, are:

- 1. Trial Pitting 1-2 Days Daily working hours are 08:00 to 18:00
- 2. Plate Testing 1 2 Days Daily working hours are 08:00 to 18:00
- 3. Cable Percussion Boreholing 1-2 Days Daily working hours are 08:00 to 18:00

Ideally all three would take place at the same time to limit time on site and is likely to mean that machinery will be left on site overnight, and the continuation of surveying the next morning.
